Neighbourhood Watch CEO Bambi Gordon said that we all want to feel like we live in an area that is neighbourly where you can recognise and connect with others.

"After coming out of a time when we have all been so disconnected, it is so important to foster a sense of true neighbourhood so people can look out for each other, and reach out when they need," Ms Gordon said.
