ULTIMATE JAPAN

Blossom trees, Mt Fuji, sushi and sumo wrestling. There's nothing quite like a trip to Japan to experience unique culture, landscapes, food and attractions.

Japan is a unique country of contrasts, where the ultra-modern and extremely traditional often sit side-by-side. Ancient temples neighbour hip shopping districts. Traditional restaurants vie for your trade next to quirky arcades. High-speed bullet trains whizz you past centuries-old monuments.

With so much to see and do, here's what makes Japan a fascinating place to visit.

JAPAN'S ANCIENT HISTORY

As a country that is 15 million years old with evidence of early inhabitancy since 30,000 BC, Japan was officially founded by Emperor Jimmu in 660 BC. It is an island nation made up of nearly 7,000 islands, of which 430 are inhabited, making it the second-largest island country after Indonesia.

Japan's safety, low crime rates, and pristine environments, combined with UNESCO sites, make it a top travel destination. The country's distinctive culture and history, from samurai warriors to modern neutrality, add to its allure.

RICH CULTURE

Japan's rich culture offers visitors a variety of experiences. Temples and shrines are integral to understanding the country's two main religions, Shinto and Buddhism. Must-visit temples include the stunning Kiyomizu-dera, the iconic Fushimi Inari in Kyoto, and Hokuji Temple in Kamakura, surrounded by a bamboo forest. You can even experience Japanese spirituality by staying overnight in a temple or a traditional ryokan.

A quintessential experience in Japan is participating in a tea ceremony. Sadō, or the "Way of Tea," is a formal practice of drinking green tea that's laden with rituals and mindfulness, offering deep insight into Japanese culture.

NATURAL BEAUTY

Japan's natural beauty is equally captivating, with four distinct seasons. Spring brings cherry blossoms, transforming the landscape into a fairytale-like scene. Autumn paints national parks with vivid reds and oranges. Winter turns Japan into a skier's paradise, particularly in regions like Hokkaido. Summer draws visitors to Okinawa's white-sand beaches and crystal-clear waters, perfect for snorkelling and scuba diving.

For those who love the outdoors, Japan's mountainous terrain offers excellent opportunities for hiking, biking,

camping, and more. With 67 per cent of the country covered in forests, nature enthusiasts can explore places like the Sagano Bamboo Forest in Arashiyama and the eerie Aokigahara Forest. Of course, hiking Mt. Fuji is an iconic experience.

FABULOUS FOOD

Food is another highlight of Japanese travel. Renowned for its seafood, Japan ranks second in global seafood consumption. Sushi, dating back 2,000 years, is ubiquitous, from convenience stores to top restaurants. While in Japan, try okonomiyaki, a savoury pancake dish, and don't forget to challenge your taste buds with nattō, a fermented soybean dish.

ONLY IN JAPAN

For something uniquely Japanese, watch a sumo wrestling match, enjoy a Noh drama performance, or race through Tokyo's streets in a Mario Kart experience. For ultimate relaxation, experience a traditional onsen bath or visit Jigokudani, where you can see snow monkeys bathing in hot springs.
