Hot cross buns are traditionally eaten on Good Friday, but these artisan buns by Le Petit Gâteau at 458 Little Collins Street, Melbourne, are yours to enjoy throughout Easter. Crafted annually since 2009, Café Manager Alex Hall attributes their alchemy to a combination of baking principles.

"You have to start with well-hydrated dough and balance the spices with the soaked fruits," Alex says. "Allowing the dough to ferment slowly at the right temperature helps to enhance the flavours. And, finally, the daily freshly baked buns have the perfect cross and the right amount of sugar glaze, brushed while the buns are still hot."

An AFL great for the Western Bulldogs and Richmond, Nathan Brown finds the same team spirit of connection and community with his RACV Club membership.

A chance encounter with a mate at a family holiday was the catalyst for former AFL star Nathan Brown joining RACV Club early in 2025.

Nathan's post-AFL career as a radio and television football commentator keeps him focused on game day. Socially, he was also looking to connect with a likeminded community outside of AFL.

"I first heard about RACV Club when a good mate of mine (sports producer/documentarian), Luke Tunnecliffe, told me about the perks of being a member when we were at the RACV Noosa Resort," Nathan says.

# ALL THAT JAZZ

Take a host of star jazz musicians on a midweek evening at City Club, add a restorative beverage or two – and members have the recipe for sonorous relaxation.

Jazz music epitomised “freedom of expression” to luminary composer Duke Ellington. In keeping, jazz devotee and RACV Club squash group president Geoff Chambers instigated discussions in 2022 that led to the ongoing Midweek Jazz events at RACV Club’s Wine Bar.

Geoff was also instrumental, so to speak, in introducing Melbourne’s premier jazz promoter, Michael Tortoni, to the Club.

“Initially, (Michael) worked with my son, RACV Club Member Engagement Coordinator Robert Chambers, to select appropriate artists to showcase fortnightly in the Wine Bar, and also in larger rooms on occasion,” Geoff says. Robert has since spearheaded the jazz movement at RACV Club.

From Geoff’s perspective, as a “consumer” of jazz at the Club, the standouts have been the Vince Jones concerts in the City Club and RACV Healesville and Alma Zygier in the Wine Bar.

“Trumpeter Adrian Perger has been playing in the Wine Bar regularly since the program began; the sound wafts down into the Bistro, no doubt enticing some diners upstairs after they have finished their meals!” Geoff says.

Adrian is part of Midweek Jazz regulars Orlando Combo, which also features Adam Orlando on guitar, Adrian on vocals/trumpet/piano, Enzo Ruberto on double bass and Lucas Evans on drums.

Other crowd favourites include the American Songbook Project, Linda Taylor Trio and R&R, which reimagines modern hits with vintage soul. Led by the stunning voice of Rebecca Cardamone, R&R boasts Wine Bar favourite Richard Pavlidis on saxophone, Diego Villalta on guitar, Tom Flenady on double bass and Mina Yu on piano.
