Keep a copper peptide mist in your fridge and handbag. It's refreshing, hydrating and packed with skin-repairing peptides.

INTERNAL HYDRATION

Add LaGaia lavender water drops to your water bottle for a calming, skin-supporting boost. Staying hydrated is essential for maintaining your skin's elasticity and glow.

REAPPLY SUNSCREEN

Top up your sunscreen regularly, especially after swimming and exercise.

WHY DID YOU BECOME AN RACV CLUB MEMBER?
















This unforgettable afternoon for finalcountdown attendees offered a premium three-course lunch, a curated beverage package and top-tier entertainment.
