

2015 AUGUST GRANT RECIPIENTS

The RACV Community Foundation Committee approved a total of 42 grants worth close to \$610k for the August 2015 round of applications. Details of these grants are summarised below.

Since the establishment of the Foundation, more than 480 grants have been approved and in excess of \$3.7m has been distributed to community-based groups in Victoria.

The Foundation will continue to focus on supporting mobility in our community as its primary area of philanthropic funding, with a view to enhancing social cohesion, safety and/or, environmental sustainability.
